Roy Durrant (Labour Group) had represented Lakenham Division from 1981 to 1985.

Council was also advised of the sad passing of Mike Britch, former Managing Director of Norfolk Property Services (NPS).

Council held a minute's silence as a mark of respect.

- Council regrets the decisions of cabinet to cease outside learning services
 from and dispose of Holt Hall. Council believes Norfolk wants their county
 council to preserve this important educational, environmental,
 developmental and legacy asset for the benefit of future generations of
 young people. Council requests Cabinet to urgently revisit and reverse
 those decisions and instead develop a plan to secure the future of outdoor
 learning at Holt Hall together with the investment required to ensure its
 long term sustainability.
- Following debate and upon the motion being put to a recorded vote (Appendix A), with 25 votes in favour, 44 votes against and 2 abstentions the motion was **LOST**.

The meeting concluded at 11.30am.




