## PROPORTIONAL ALLOCATION OF SEATS ON COMMITTEES

Report by the Assistant Director of Governance

## 1. Introduction

1.1 At its first Annual General Meeting the Council is required to determine the size and composition of and appoint the membership of committees, sub committees and joint committees.

## 2. Allocations

2.1 There are 99 main committee places. The overall composition of the County Council is now 58 Conservative, 11 Labour, 8 Liberal Democrat, 3 Green Group, 2 Independent group, 1 non-aligned Member and 1 vacancy. Based on the above Council composition, when the proportionality formula is applied the allocation of the 99 committee places to political groups should be as follows:
Conservative 70

Labour 13
Liberal Democrats 10
Green Group 04
Independent Group 02
TOTAL 99
2.2 Group Leaders have discussed the allocation of places and Table 1 sets out the proposal for the main committees. It is for Council to finally determine the allocation.
