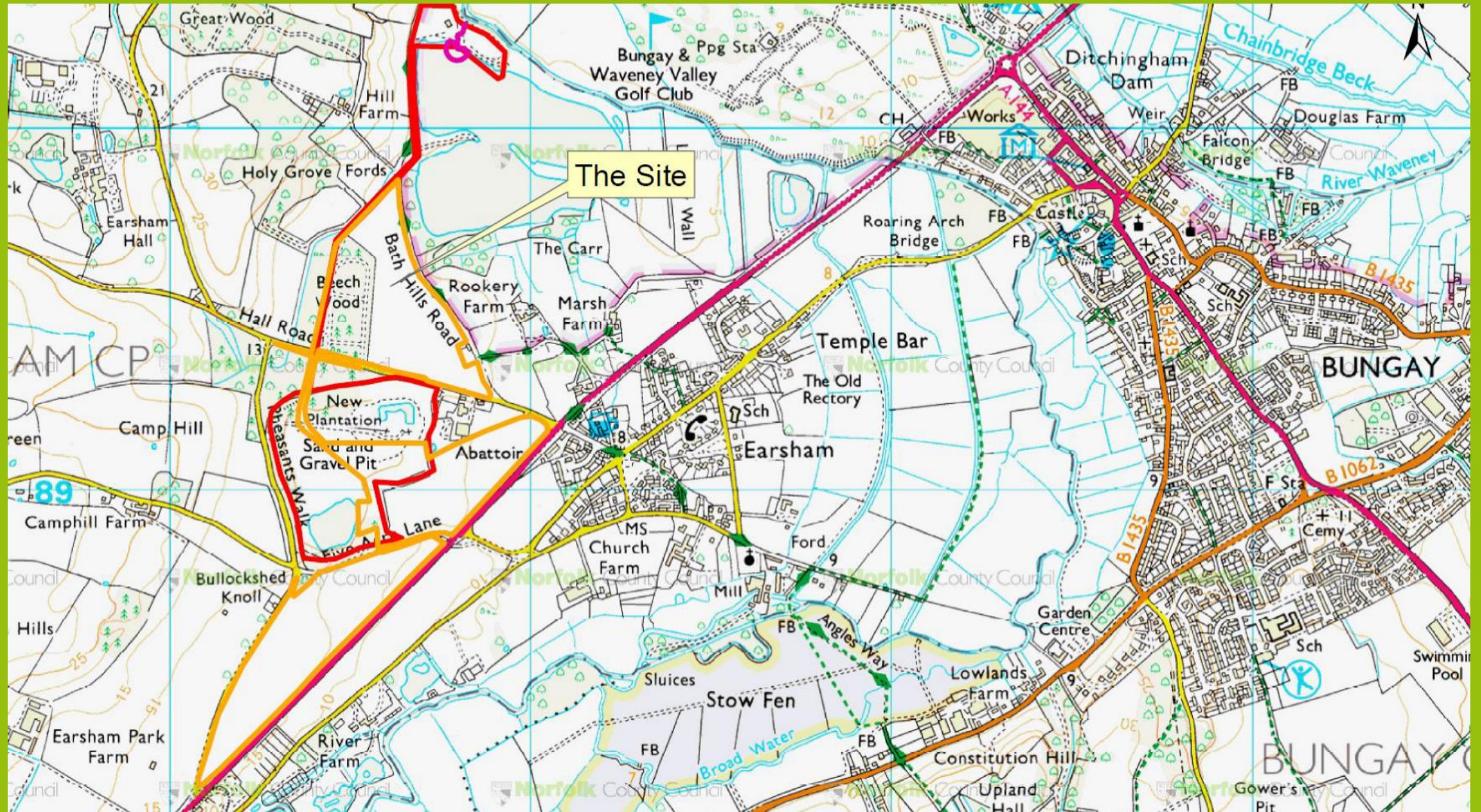

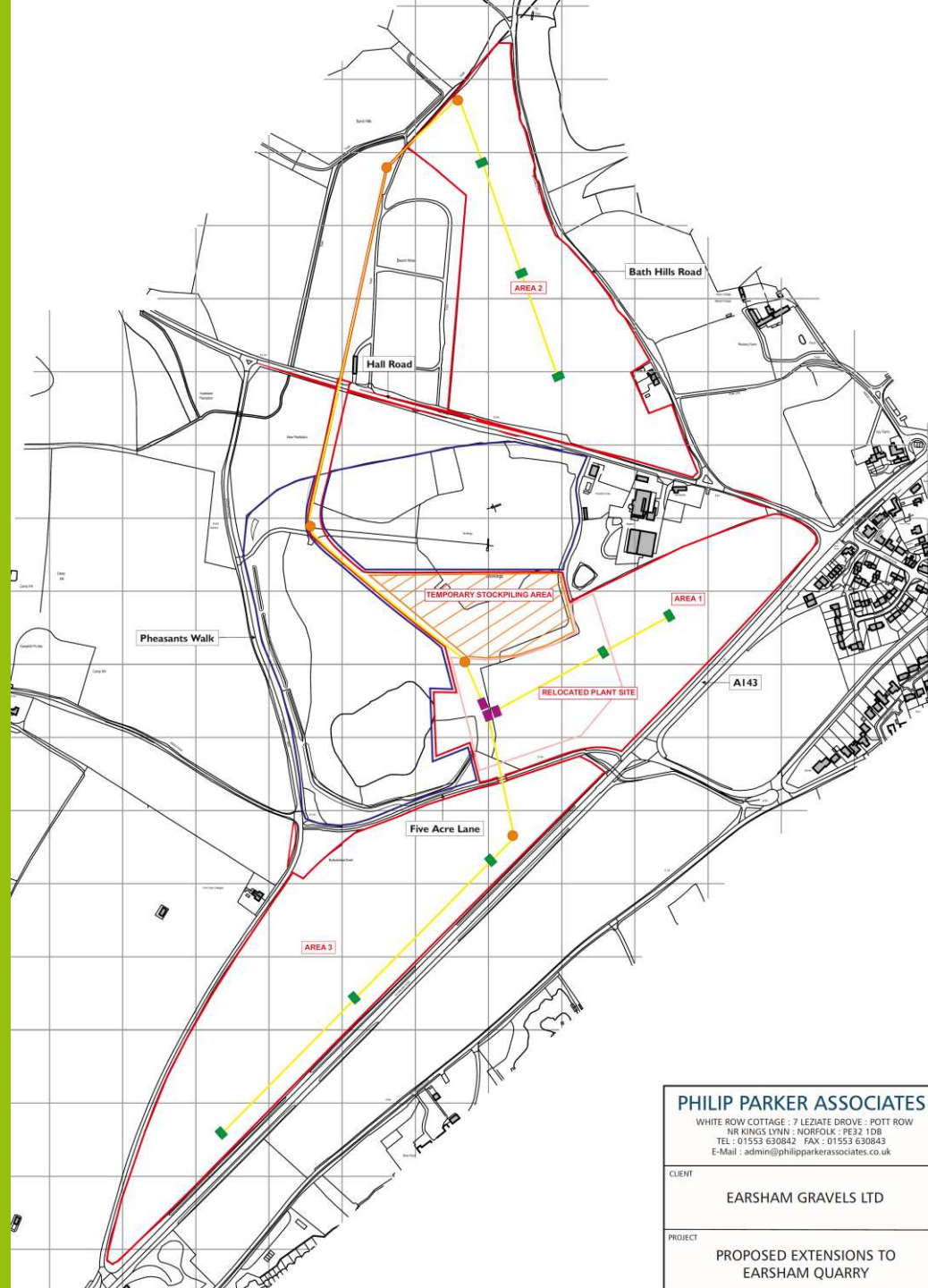

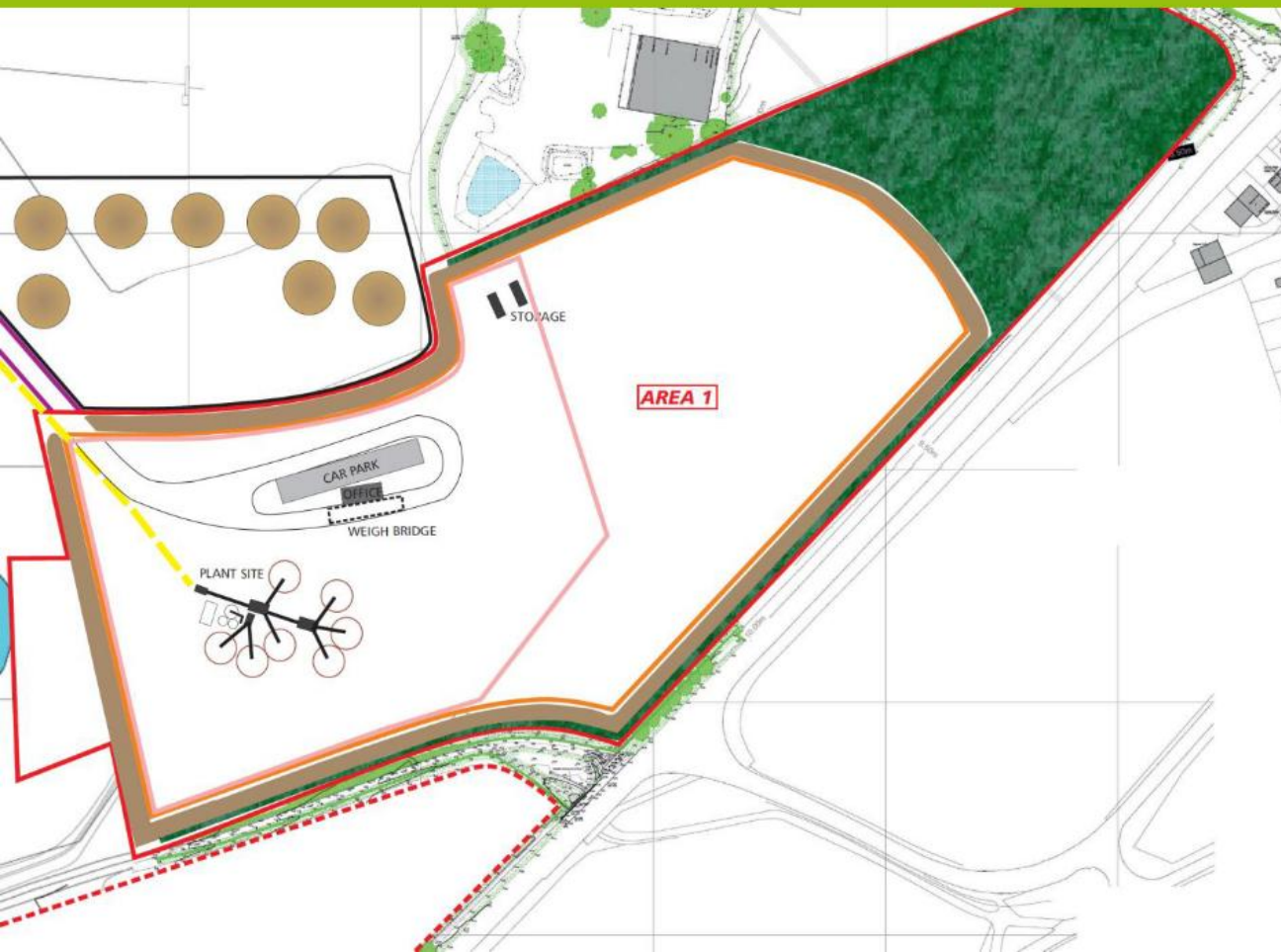

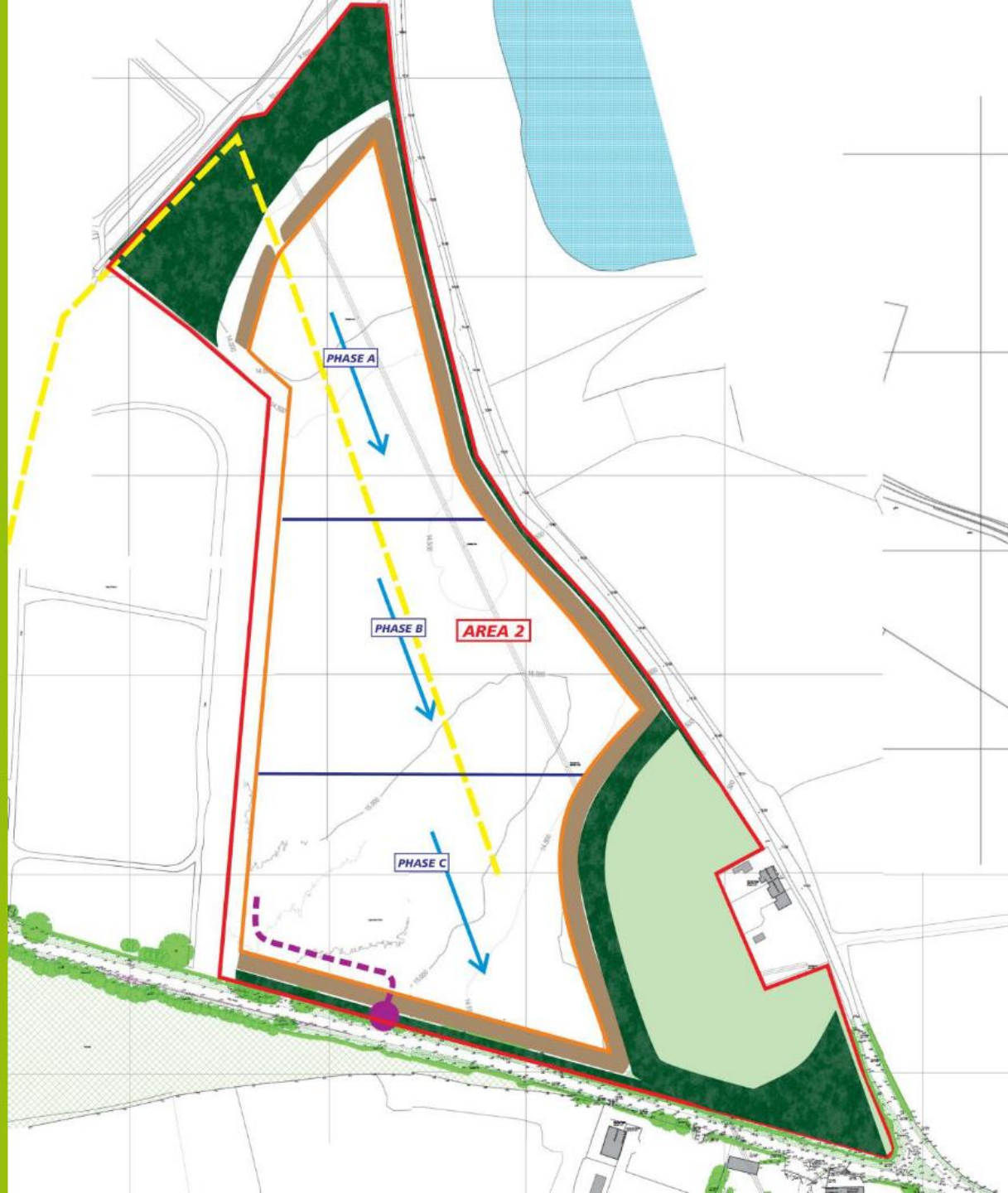
Acid grassland on sandy subsoil extended from the existing, supporting declining species such as brown hare + skylark. Ultimately the site will provide an extension to the successful restoration of the existing quarry

Geological exposure/sand martin + insect bank (indicative position)

Wetland feature at base of the land form to comprise an area of seasonally damp/wet grassland with pond complexes on a sandy substrate base, designed to support amphibians, reptiles + invertebrates such as dragonflies

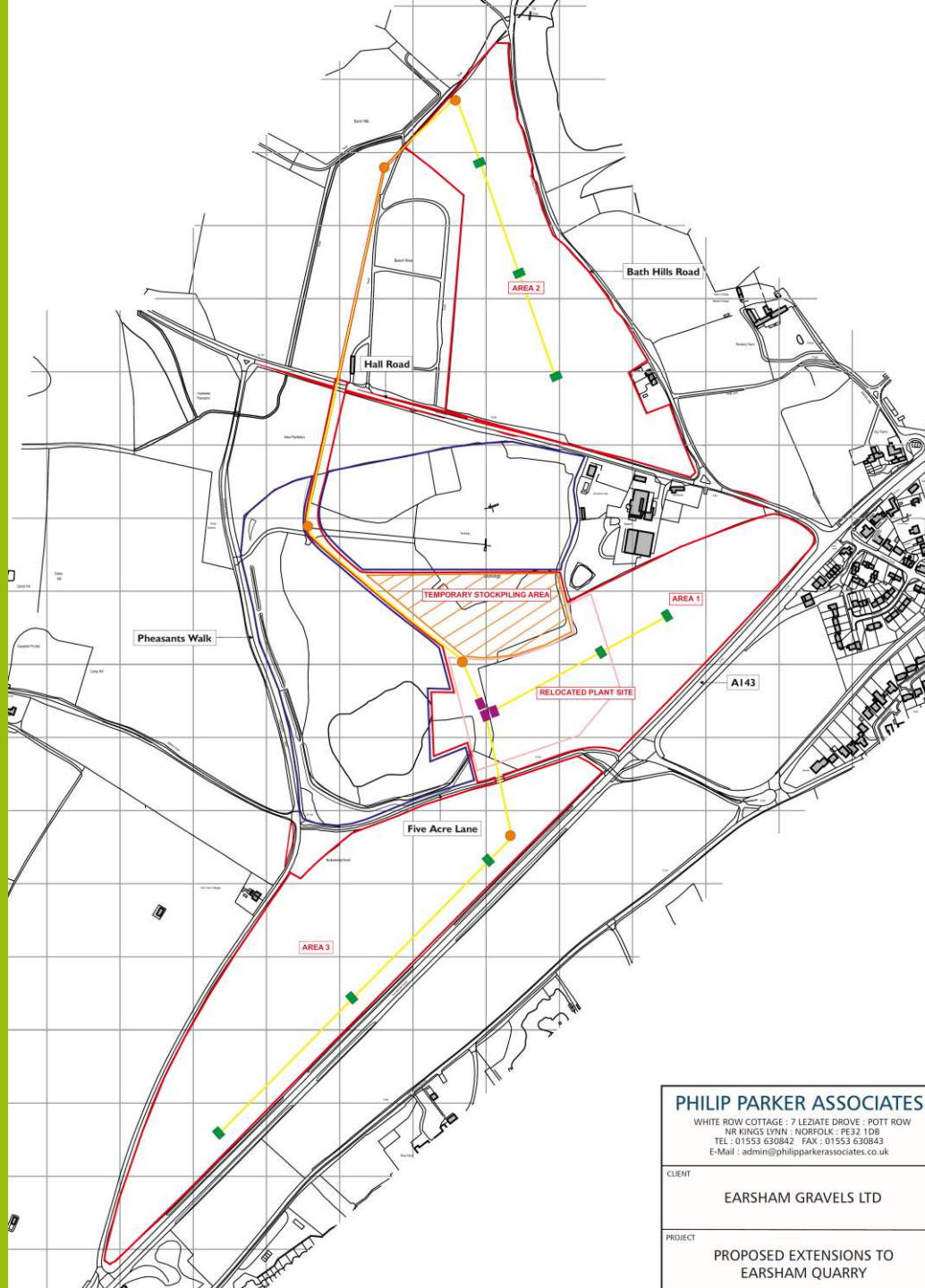
